

Botriphnie Gravestone Inscriptions.

About 1978 a group of young people working on a Youth Opportunities Programme recorded all the gravestone inscriptions in Moray. Many of the stones were very difficult to read, sometimes due to the type of stone used, sometimes to the build-up of algae and lichen, sometimes because the stones were partially or completely buried and sometimes because they were so unstable as to be dangerous. In 2004, the Moray Burial Research Group, under the leadership of Bruce Bishop and working in co-operation with the Council for Scottish Archaeology and the Scottish Association of Family History Societies, carried out a detailed program of recording to correct and update the list. We are deeply indebted to all these for carrying out the work and then allowing us to present them on this website.

The gravestone numbering system used consists of the prefix Bt (for Botriphnie) followed by a number that simply identifies each headstone as shown in the accompanying [gravestone plan](#). Note that the headstone numbers are quite separate from the numbers of the lairs on which they stand. Where known, the lair numbers are given after the headstone numbers. Lairs were usually purchased in groups and it is the whole group that is usually referred to.

Note also that the Record Book recording the burials taking place before 1899 has been lost but the information on who purchased the lairs was carried forward to the later books. Because of this, the only record of the earlier burials is on the gravestones themselves. Of course, in many cases no gravestone was erected so we sometimes get the situation where a family purchased a number of lairs and no record exists of them having been used.

Monumental Inscriptions Recorded and Checked by the Moray Burial Research Group in 2004.

Bt 1. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

In hopes of a blessed resurrection. Here lyes the body of BEATRIX REMNER spouse to JOHN SELLAR, Shenval who erected this to her memorie. She departed this life August the 28 day 1738 aged 40 years.

Bt 2. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

Here is the burial place of JAMES GALL & his spouse CHRISTIAN WHELANS... the (?) July 1750. I.G., C.W.

Bt 3. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

Here lyes the body of PETER MILN who was Milnward at Miln of Towie for 46 years and departed this life 7th February 1731. Likewise his spouse AGNES DUNCAN who departed this life 3d July 1730.

Bt 4. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

Here lies the dust of WILLAM (sic) BURGES lawful son to CHARLES BURGESS & CIRSTAN FORBES who departed this life Iune 4 1730.

Bt 5. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

Here lyes THOMAS SELLAR who departed this life May 2n. 1728.

Bt 6. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

Here lyes the dust of JANET BAIRD, spouse.... Towie Beeg who dyed the 2d day of January. ROBERT GALL ther son who dyed in Feb. 1728. A.G., I.B. (*on heraldic device*).

Bt 7. Rough piece of stone.

M.C. 17A1 (*1771?*).

Bt 8. Table Stone top or Recumbent Stone now against wall.

Here lies JAMES MIL... who dyed 1671.

Bt 9. (Lair 754, 755)

In memory ALEXANDER ALLAN 1875 - 1940, ANNABEL H. ALLAN 1920-1921, BARBARA M. HAY 1883-1952, wife of ALEXANDER ALLAN, late of Lochend.

Bt 10. (Lair 751, 752, 753)

In loving memory of CHARLES ANNAND, died at Newburgh, Botriphnie 10th Dec. 1928 aged 76 years, also his wife ISABELLA KESSACK died 4th April 1929 aged 75 years. Their daughter JESSIE ANN died at Broomhill, Botriphnie 14th June 1919 aged 37 years. Erected by ANNABELLA and ROBERT ANNAND.

Bt 11. (Lair 749,750)

Erected by JAMES LAING in memory of his daughter JANET, died at Home Farm 5th Oct. 1923 aged 18. Also his son JOCKIE who died in Berwickshire 25th February 1928 aged 4 years and 8 months.

Bt 12. (Lair 735, 736)

In loving memory of GEORGE CRAIB, aged 6 weeks.

Bt 13. (Lair 737, 738, 739)

Erected by MARY COBBAN in memory of her beloved husband WILLIAM COBBAN, House Carpenter, Aberdeen, died at Brankie 7th May 1872 aged 34 years.

Bt 14. (Lair 740, 741, 742)

Erected by members of the family in loving remembrance of JOHN COCKBURN who died at Braeside, Kininvie 5th Augt. 1888 aged 74 years, also of their brother CHARLES who died at Braeside 3rd June 1864 aged 10 years. Also their mother JANE ANDERSON who died at Braeside 11th May 1890 aged 70 years. In loving memory of my wife ISABELLA ROBERTSON who died at Jocks Lodge, Boharm, 19th Sep. 1929 aged 73 years, and the above WILLIAM COCKBURN who died at Kingsmills House, Elgin, 28th Dec. 1934 aged 82 years. "The ransomed of the Lord shall return. Isa. 33.10".

Bt 15. (Lair 743, 744)

Face of Stone.

In memory of WILLIAM COCKBURN, late Overseer at Craigenseat who died there on the 1st of July 1842 aged 35 years, son of JOHN COCKBURN and MARGARET GORDON in Brankie. JOHN COCKBURN died in 1848 aged 82 and MARGARET GORDON died in 1846 aged 73

Reverse of Stone

Here lyes the dust of ROBERT COBAN lawful son of MARGARET SELLAR in Blackmuir, who lived Christianly & departed this life the 8th Septr. 1748(?) aged ... *Remainder Illegible*. "Here sleeps in death, a parent's stay whom God called in his bloom away".

And of GEORGE COCKBURN, Tobacconist in Keith who died 18th February 1874 aged 73 years. And of JANET DUFF who died 26th April 1875 aged 63. 21. And his wife MARGARET BURGESS died East Lodge 2.2.1941 aged 72, his son JOHN died Keith 29.9.1942 aged 39 also the above mentioned JOHN WATT died 13.11.1944 aged 64.

Their sons JOHN ROBERTSON DAVIDSON died 10th January 1969 aged 55 years, WILLIAM DAVIDSON died 15th April 1973 aged 68 years.

In memory of my husband CHARLES CAMERON who died at Curlusk, Boharm, 22nd June 1912 aged 53 years. His son HARRY died of wounds in France 7th April 1918 aged 24. Also his nephew Pt. PETER A. STRACHAN who died at Edinburgh 5th Sep. 1918 aged 29. His wife JANE ANN MCKAY who died at Curlusk 10th June 1956 aged 80 and their son WILLIAM who died at Curlusk 3rd April 1957 aged 58 years.

Bt 21. (Lair 709, 710, 711, 712, 713)

In loving memory of ALEXANDER MILNE who died at Greens of Woodend 5th April 1937 aged 73 and his wife JANE SPENCE who died there 11th Dec. 1940 aged 77.

Bt 22. (Lair 701, 702, 703, 704, 705)

In memory of ALEXANDER MILNE, Feuar, Dufftown, who died there on the 26th September 1862 aged 71 years, and ANN TAYLOR his wife who died at the Schoolhouse, Dufftown on the 15th October 1887 aged 93 years. Also of WILLIAM MILNE, Surgeon, their third son who died at sea on the 29th May 1884 aged 54 years. Also of GEORGE their eldest (son) who died at Aberdeen on 12th September 1910 aged 88 years.

Bt 23. Flat Stone (Lair 701, 702, 703, 704, 705)

In memory sacred. This stone is erected by PETER MILNE after a residence of 23 years in the West Indies in commemoration of his affection to his beloved mother, brothers and sisters, viz; HELEN MITCHELL, late wife of ALEXANDER MILNE, Maltkiln, Mortlach, who departed this life 19th day of June 1838 in the 73rd year of her age, ROBERT, eldest brother, who died 28th day of June 1828 in the 35th year of his age. MARY, eldest sister, who died 17th day of April 1822 in the 25th year of her age. JAMES, younger brother, died 13th day of May 1837 in the 35th year of his age. The above PETER MILNE Esqr., the erector of this stone, died Barbados 11th day of February 1818 aged 30 years. ALEXANDER MILNE, Maltkiln, died 11th of March 1851 aged 86 years. HELEN MILNE died 3rd February (sic) 1837 aged 8. GEORGE M. MILNE died the 11th of February (sic) 1863 aged 28. JANE MILNE died the 19th January 1864 aged 31 years. ALEXANDER MILNE, son of ALEX^R MILNE, late of Maltkiln died at the Fife Arms Hotel, Dufftown 28th day of May 1871 aged 65 years. The three names immediately before this were of this family also and of his spouse JANE GRANT, who died 18th January 1881 aged 80 years. This humble monument erected the 12 day of August 1839.

Along bevelled edge of the flat stone;
HELEN MILNE who died the 20th August 1892 aged 50 years.

Bt 24_.(Lair 691, 692, 693, 694, 695, 696)

In loving memory of GEORGE, died 15th March 1932 aged 10½ years, and CONSTANCE, died in infancy. Children of ANDREW & ELIZABETH GEDDES, Broomhill, Botriphnie. ELIZABETH died 3rd Nov. 1937 aged 15. Also ALLAN JAMES died 9th April 1939 aged 3½.

Bt 25_.(Lair 691, 692, 693, 694, 695, 696)

In memory of JOHN MacDONALD died Easterton Cottage 22nd May 1936 aged 77 years, and his son JAMES fell in action in France 27th Sep. 1915 aged 20, and his wife JANE GORDON died Huntly 2nd June 1945 aged 80 years.

Bt 26_.(Lair 676, 677, 678)

Stone Recorded on 1978 Survey, now missing.

In loving memory of our little baby ELLA, daughter of WILLIAM ADAM, died Glenheath 9.5.1912 aged 15 weeks.

Bt 27_.(Lair 675)

In memory of JOHN LORIMER, sometime farmer in Mains of Ardrack died Janry 15th 1769 aged 63 years and his wife ANN RAINY who died Ardrack 6 March 1758 aged 56 years. & Their children JAMES and JOHN died in nonoage (*sic*). Also JANNET ORD wife of WILLIAM LORIMER who died 16th June 1805 aged 69 years. The fore said WILLIAM LORIMER died Midtown of Bellyhack Febr'y 1816 aged 75 years. To perpetuate the memory of the best of relations this stone is placed here by WILLIAM LORIMER, farmer in Midtown of Bellyhack 16th March 1807.

The first part of this inscription is recorded from the 1978 Survey, being now inaccessible. The second half was read as part of current Survey.

First section.

Near this stone was buried the body of PETER McPHAIL 1709, and also the body of his son GEORGE McPHAIL, 1774, in the 67th year of his age. Also the body of GEORGE McPHAIL, son of the above GEORGE, 1818, in the 69th year of his age.

Second section.

Here likewise lies ROBERT McPHAIL (son of the within GEORGE McPHAIL, senr.) Blacksmith in Nova Scotia 36 years, who died at Cachenhead 8th March 1835 aged 78.

Also of their son ROBERT 1837 aged 3 years and of their son WILLIAM died Elgin 19.6.1851 aged 30 years. Also of their daughter JANE died Elgin 5.8.1852 aged 20 years and of ANN died England 30.10.1871 aged 40 years.

Bt 33_.(Lair 669, 670, 671)

Erected by MARY McLEAN in memory of her beloved husband JAMES SELLAR who died at Tongue, Kininvie, 6th Decr. 1895 aged 63 years. Also the above MARY McLEAN who died at Dufftown 5th Nov. 1922 aged 89 years.

Bt 34_.(Lair 669, 670, 671)

SELLAR.

In loving memory of JOHN SELLAR, Feuar, Land St., Keith, who died at Aberdeen 6th Oct. 1899 aged 68 years and of his wife JANE McROBERT who died at Keith 8th April 1875 aged 49 years. Also of their daughter MARGARET who died in infancy and of their son JOHN SELLAR who died at Aberdeen 18th Oct. 1924 aged 64 years, and his son JOHN KEITH SELLAR 1896-1954.

West Face.

This is thought to have been the first gravestone in this Church Yard marking the burial ground of the SELLARS, a race of Blacksmiths for 400 years as may be seen on the other side. Under it lies the body of ROBERT SELLAR, Blacksmith in Tenantown who died Janry. 1815 in the 57th year.... of the...race. Also his spouse ISABEL HAY who died 26th May 1851 aged 80. Their second ROBERT died March .. (4?)th 1821 aged 23 at Pitsfield Ma(s).... America, & their 5th FRANCES died bathing at Aberdeen Augt. 1828 aged 19, his bous (*sic*) lie here.

Erected by FORBES KEITH SELLAR in memory of his father.

In loving memory of JESSIE GAULD, wife of HUGH McINTOSH died at Glack, Botriphnie, 17th Feb. 1909 aged 75 years. The above HUGH McINTOSH who died at Coldhome, Auchindoun, 5th April 1926 aged 88 years.

Bt 37_.(Lair 647, 648, 649, 650, 651)

Erected by JAMES GEORGE and ANN GAULD, Mains of Drummuir, in memory of their daughter ISABELLA, died July the 17th 1860 aged 24 years. Also their son JOHN died 9th February 1861 aged 30 years. The above JAMES GEORGE died 7th January 1871 aged 75 years, also his wife ANN GAULD who died at Mains of Drummuir 12th December 1872 aged 77 years. Also their son JAMES GEORGE who died at Invermarkie, Glass, 1st Oct. 1887 aged 59 years.

Bt 38_.(Lair 652, 653, 654, 655, 656, 657)

Here lyes JANET DUNCAN who depart this life January 28 1699, spouse to JAMES SELLAR.

Bt 39_.(Lair 652, 653, 654, 655, 656, 657)

Bt 40_.(Lair 658, 659, 660)

Erected in memory of WILLIAM WILSON who died at Lennoch Cottage, Botriphnie 24th Oct. 1911 aged 67 years, also his wife HELEN EDWARD who died at Lennoch Cottage 5th Dec. 1919 aged 78 years. Their son JAMES EDWARD who died at Lennoch Cottage 15th Jan. 1926 aged 57 years, and ANN McCULLOCH, wife of the above JAMES EDWARD died at Daleigh Cottage, Advie 16th May 1939 aged 69 years.

Bt 41_.(Lair 606, 607, 608, 609)

Here lies the body of JOHN ORD, sometime Mason in Croft G... who departed this life 8.10.1775 in the 66th year of his age. This stone was erected by CICILIA HARPER his spouse.

Bt 42. (Lair 626, 627, 628, 629, 630, 631, 632)

In loving memory of ELIZA, eldest daughter of ALEXANDER BURGESS, Braehead, who died 2nd April 1906 aged 46 years. JESSIE, third daughter, died 8th February 1907 aged 39 years. MARY, fourth daughter, died 24th Decr. 1908 aged 39 years. His son ALEXANDER ADAM died 3rd Aug. 1915 aged 57 years. His wife ELIZA M. AUCHINACHIE died 23rd May 1918 aged 83 years, and the above ALEXANDER BURGESS died 10th March 1922 aged 94 years. Also his daughter MARGARET died at Keith 18th May 1940 aged 76 years. "Underneath are the everlasting arms. Until the day break".

His brothers HUGH, Farmer, Towie, died there 26th Oct. 1889 aged 69, PETER, Farmer, Howdoup, died at Buckie 25th Aug. 1890 aged 68. His wife ANN ROBERTSON died at Tenrood 21st Feb. 1863 aged 35. JAMES, Carpenter, Towie, died there 9th Nov. 1861 aged 27. His nephew GEORGE, Carpenter, Keith, died there 11th Aug. 1900 aged 40. His son GEORGE died at Keith 9th Dec. 1901 aged 14 months. Also the said THOMAS SHEARER died at Keith 19th March 1902 aged 66.

Erected by GEORGE SHEARER in memory of his beloved wife JANE DAVIDSON who died at Keith 18th Sep. 1896 aged 33. Also their family ELIZABETH BARBARA JEANNIE who died at Corsairty 1st Dec. 1908 aged 13 years. JEANIE, HUGH and JESSIE HELEN who all died in infancy. ALEXANDER who died at Boulougne, France, 15th Sep. 1916 aged 26.

Face of Stone.

In memory of JOHN SHEARER, some-time Farmer at Oldlenach who died June 29th 1824 aged 84 years. Also MAGDALEN MILNE, spouse to his son GEORGE SHEARER, Sawmiller, Tenrood, who died 1st Jan. 1819 aged 41 years. And JAMES SHEARER their son who died 20th May 1819 aged..., likewise JOHN SHEARED died 21st Decr 1822 aged 19 years.

Also our dear brothers ALEXANDER who died at Bowlins, Keith, 28th Nov. 1891 aged 15 years, GEORGE, Tea Planter, India, who died at Station House, Dufftown, 10th Feb. 1918 aged 33

years. Also our dear brother WILLIAM, Farmer, who died at Knepp Castle Home Farm, West Grinstead, Sussex, on 3rd Feb. 1924 aged 44 years.

West face of Stone (In 1978 Transcription this is referred to as Stone 51a).

Also their son-in-law GEORGE STABLES, Rubber Planter, who died at Penang 9th June 1915 aged 31 years, interred in Para-Buntar Cemetery there. Also our dear brother JOHN, Tea Planter, India, who died 12th Nov. 1955 aged 64 years, and his dear wife EVALINA SIM who died 21st July 1996 aged 102 years.

Bt 52. (Lair 606, 607, 608, 609)

In memory of ALEXANDER ORD, Farmer in Blackhall who died 1823 aged 60 years. JANET PEARSON his wife who died 1801 aged 24 years. JOHN ORD their son who died 1st January 1892 in his 94th years. ANN McWILLIE his wife who died 19th May 1895 aged 97 years.

Early Emblems of Mortality on reverse of stone, possibly a recycled tombstone.

Bt 53. (Lair 606, 607, 608, 609)

Erected in memory of JOHN ORD, late Farmer, Ardbrack, who died the 24th April 1779 aged 52 years, and also of MARGARET McGOWEN his spouse who died 30th April 1804 aged 60 years. Also of their daughter HELEN, wife of ALEXANDER MILN Esq. of Chapeltown, who died at Elgin September 1823 aged 51 years. And her son HARRY MILNE, sometime merchant in Elgin died at Whitewreath 24th July 1853 aged 54 years. Also ALEXANDRINA MILNE her daughter who died at Henry Cottage, Elgin, 6th day of June 1863 aged 61 years.
